# PROGRAMME

Dear colleagues,

In collaboration with the German Society of Phlebology, the 17th international compact training course on sclerotherapy will take place on Friday, 24 January 2025 in Munich. The intention of this course is to learn the basics of liquid and foam sclerotherapy of varicose veins, both theoretically and practically, and to be able to eliminate varicose veins effectively and safely.

Moreover, recommendations of the most recent international congresses and consensus conferences will be conveyed, including advices of sclerotherapy management.

Diagnosis is assigned an important role: During the course, the highly differentiating diagnostics with colour-duplex sonography will be explained. This method, and the related "leg vein cartography", has become the diagnostic standard prior to the therapy all over Europe.

The practical part involves live demonstrations of various sclerotherapy techniques as well as post-sclerotherapy procedures. Patients will be examined and treated according to their individual indications. All parts of the programme will provide enough time to ask and discuss specific questions on the therapy and the entire procedure.
